



24 melodic lines on the changes to classics by Duke Ellington, Billy Strayhorn, Thelonious Monk, Henry Mancini, George Shearing, Bronislaw Kaper, Gene de Paul, Jerome Kern, George Gershwin, Richard Rogers, Cole Porter, etc. Each line is in Concert G and F clef, Bb, and Eb, and a piano part with a walking bass and a simple right hand comp. These studies include phrases with "outside" concepts but are mainly based on bebop and post-bop vocabulary. Also included is a Phrase Bank of selected ideas from each study, each fully analyzed. The Structural Analysis section functions as a course on composition, delineating the harmonic bases of North-American popular music song construction. 240 pp.


MODAL BLUES ETUDES

An all G-clef instruments book of blues pieces, each based on a different mode. "These 20 studies grew out of an idea I have had for some time, to fuse blues forms - traditional and modern, with different modes, some of which are infrequently used in the blues. They include tributes to some of my favorite musicians, a twelve-tone blues, two whole tone blues, half tone-whole tone and augmented scales, and a tribute to Alexander Tcherepnin using his nine-tone scale, as well as blues in modes of the major and melodic minor scales. 32 pp.





This suite of pieces mixes jazz and contemporary classical harmony with many different rhythmic feels within the jazz, pop, Brazilian, and latin music worlds. 74 pp.



PENTAKOSMOS


These 24 pieces are based on many different pentatonic scales from different cultures including India and Japan. The compositions present a panorama of musical styles including jazz, blues, flamenco, and latin jazz, as well as Brazilian rhythms such as afoxé and maracatu. 86 pp.

Pentakosmos, this wonderful compendium of original works written for piano, reveals not only the composer's capacity for creative intelligence, but also his profound command of the instrument and of musical language in its harmonic, melodic, rhythmic and structural aspects. Each piece offers pianists the opportunity to experience the composer's sonic universe, full of jazz ideas and influences from various styles and genres from many countries. This cosmos of ideas, which involve the pentatonic universe, defines, aside from the artistic contribution, an important didactic material that fills a gap in the piano repertoire.


Considering the limitation of the traditional piano repertoire, which is largely based on the European repertoire, I recommend the inclusion of this book in piano course programs, so that pianists can develop their musicality and psychomotricity, as well as motivate themselves through a modern repertoire that is artistically attractive to the ears.



BRAZILIAN MOODS FOR PIANO

These pieces are based on Brazilian rhythms including baião, chorinho, samba, and bossa nova. 24 pp.

Level: Beginning - intermediate.




JAZZ PIANO ETUDES

This collection of 24 studies includes pieces based on jazz concepts such as fifths, fourths, pentatonics, ostinati, polytonality, and intervallic systems. There are also two studies for the left-hand alone - Danza de las Sombras, an impressionist tribute to Federico Mompou, and Blues for Phineas, a tribute to Phineas Newborn. 84 pp.



C. Handy's classic Saint Louis Blues. 41 pp.



RADAMESIANAS + NOTURNO + PACO Y CAMERON

Radamesianas is a suite of three concert waltzes dedicated to Radames Gnattali, mixing contemporary jazz harmony with elements of contemporary Brazilian composition. Noturno is a study in left hand arpeggios that underpin a chordal melody in the right hand based on Brazilian rhythmical cells. Paco y Cameron is a synthesis of Jazz, Flamenco, and contemporary classical harmony. 24 pp.



SONGS OF INNOCENCE

This collection contains three simple pieces as well as a #3, challenging piece with a baião left hand under a Bach-like line in the right hand. #5 is a ballad in an Americana style with influences of Aaron Copland and jazz harmony. 12 pp.



This is a set of 55 completely notated two-hand arrangements for solo piano of some of the greatest all-time jazz standards, organized in 5 volumes, each with 10 standards. Great as an individual study aid exemplifying different voicing and reharmonization techniques and/or as a resource for jazz piano and theory.
